



INSTRUCTIONS: CRIERS (THROW OUT TWO WORSE HOLES)

INDIVIDUAL PLAY FORMAT

Scorecards do not need to be stroked.

Captains will place each player's handicap in the "HCP" (handicap) column on the scorecard. Handicap cannot be greater than 27.

1. Captains collect \$2.25 from each player. Two players keep score. Captains will remind their team to be aware of "pace of play". Captains will add "Start Time" and "End Time" to their score cards, and calculate and record the elapsed time on the card before turning it in to the scorers.

2. Players pick up after 8, 9, or 10 strokes - "Equitable Stroke Control"

Course Handicap	Maximum Strokes
10-14	8
15-19	9
20 or more	10

3. To calculate your score, first cross out your two worse holes. Then add the remaining 7 holes and put that number in the TOT Column.

4. Next, subtract handicap and place the total in the NET column. That is your score for the day.

Do not put scores into computer. No ringers.
