



INSTRUCTIONS: INDIVIDUAL PLAY FORMAT

1. Cash prizes for low gross/low net for each of three flights (six prizes). Closest to the pin on #15 and closest to line on #18 – Port; Closest to the pin on #17 and closest to the line on #13 – Starboard).
2. Scorecards do not need to be stroked.
3. Captains do not collect any money. Two players keep score. Captains will remind their team to be aware of “pace of play”. Captains will add “Start Time” and “End Time” to their score cards, and calculate and record the elapsed time on the card before turning it in to the scorers.
4. Captains will place each player’s handicap in the “HCP” (handicap) column on the scorecard. Handicap cannot be greater than 27.
5. Players pick up after 8, 9, or 10 strokes - “Equitable Stroke Control”

Course Handicap	Maximum strokes
10-14	8
15-19	9
20 or more	10

6. Gross scores should be entered in the “Tot” column.
7. Net score should be entered in the “net” column. Subtract handicap from gross score to determine net score.
8. Captains post gross scores into the computer for team members.
9. Coffee and donuts after play!
