



INSTRUCTIONS: **TEAM PLAY**

1. Stroke scorecard using handicaps according to degree of handicap of each hole. Maximum of 3 strokes off any one hole. Remember to put no more than a 27 handicap on scorecard for those players who may have a higher handicap on the Pairings sheet.
2. Captains collect \$2.25 before playing. Two players keep score. Best ball of the four is team score. Captains will also remind their team to be aware of “pace of play”. Captains will add “Start Time” and “End Time” to their score cards, and calculate and record the elapsed time on the card before turning it in to the scorers.
3. Players announce number of strokes when they reach the green and use “continuous” putting, when possible, rather than marking their ball.
4. Players pick up after 8, 9, or 10 strokes - “Equitable Stroke Control”

Course Handicap	Maximum strokes
10-14	8
15-19	9
20 or more	10

Exception: During **Summer Cup** tournament, players who are participating in the tournament will not pick up balls but will play until the winner of each hole has been determined.

5. Net score should be entered in the “net” column. Subtract handicap from gross score to determine net score.
6. Captains post gross scores into the computer for team members.
